#### A few notes:


- All work must be done on a separate piece of paper. Please label the problems (Interval and Inequality Notation #1, #2, etc) and SHOW WORK. You must show work to get credit. (There are a few problems where work is not necessary.) You must bring this to class on the first day.
- You have 2 attempts at a problem. If you get a problem wrong, try to find your mistake and correct it. Otherwise you will have to deal with a penalty.
- > Explanation of penalty:
  - When you set "Required" equal to "5" problems to a student on DeltaMath, that's all they would need to do if they got 5 in a row correct and nothing wrong, but the default "penalty" on DeltaMath is "1 off" which means for each incorrect answer their score will drop by 1. So if they get 3 right (their score is 3) then one wrong (their score drops to 2), they would then need to get 3 more right in a row to reach a score of 5 (even though they got 6 right and 1 wrong).
- Once you click on the assignment, you can use the "Show Example" tool to provide help. When you are ready to provide an answer, enter in the appropriate space. Then click "Submit Answer". <u>Directions for how to submit answers are included in the video link</u>. \*\*\*IMPORTANT: to go back to the list of assignments, please use the "Back" button on the website, NOT the back button in your browser!\*\*\*



- 1. Go to www.deltamath.com.
- 2. Choose Create Account. Select Student on the pull-down menu.
- 3. Enter Teacher Code: 622140
- 4. Verify that the screen says Teacher Name: Mrs. Idasek, like below.



5. Pull down the Period menu and select PreCalculus Honors 20-21.



- 6. Fill out your First and Last Name, making sure to use your given name. Use your school email for the email and create a password. Make sure to write down your password.
- 7. Click Create Account.
