The proficiency test will assess your knowledge in Algebra 1 so you can move to Geometry or Geometry Honors.
 If you wish to take Adv. Alg. 2/Trig Honors your proficiency test will be in Alg. 1 & Geometry.

For the Class of 2023 and beyond, all students are required to take two years of the same world language for graduation. Many students have taken a world language prior to entering high school with varying degrees of proficiency. Students will be placed in a world language class based upon a variety of factors including 7th and 8th grade language teacher recommendation, entrance exam scores, and high school English placement. If your son/daughter has been recommended for level two or higher of a world language, a proficiency test is required. An assessment of Spanish 1 proficiency will be given to move into Spanish 2 or higher
